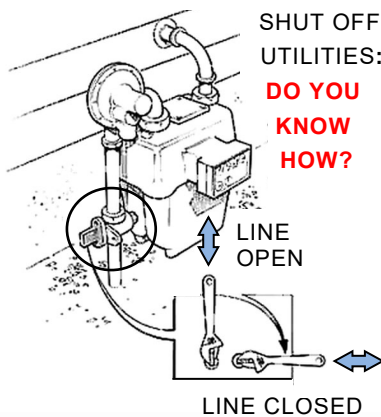


Calling Tualatin Latino Community Members!
